To provide scholarships for <u>men</u> who desire to pursue a career in the ministry as preachers of the gospel in churches of Christ <u>and women</u> pursing a Christian education at a Church of Christ affiliated college or university.

Your application and essay material should be in no later than May 30, 2023.

Scholarship Fund Guidelines

- 1. Scholarships will be awarded to qualified applicants who are members of the Church of Christ and have a high school diploma or a GED.
- 2. A letter of acceptance from an accredited Christian College/ University, Bible Institute or School of Preaching must accompany the application.
- 3. A scholarship committee will screen all applications and send written notification to the winning applicant.
- 4. In the event there are no qualified male applicants in a particular year, scholarships may be award to a female who wishes to attend a Church of Christ affiliated Christian college or university.
- 5. If there are no qualified applicants, the scholarship will be carried over to the next year.
- 6. The scholarship will only be granted to active and faithful members of those congregations which are in good standing and have met the foundation's criteria for participation.

Applicant's Criteria

- 1. Applicants must be faithful and active in church affairs.
- 2. Applicants must be enrolling as a full-time student in a Christian college, university or school of preaching.
- 3. Applicants must be recommended by his/her minister, elder or a responsible church leader.
- 4. Applicants must submit application for scholarship by the date stated in the scholarship announcements for the year in which they are applying. Two letters of recommendation, with one being from the minister, elder, or church leader, must accompany the application as stated in criteria #3. The other letter must be from a non-relative.
- 5. A letter of acceptance from the school that applicant will be attending must accompany the application as well.
- 6. Applicant must have been an active member of his/her congregation for at least 2 years.

Guidelines for Scholarship Essay

- 1. The essay should center around the following questions:
 - a. What promoted you to pursue preaching as a career?
 - b. What are your career goals?
 - c. And how will attending a Christian college, university, or seminary assist you in achieving those goals?

- 2. Male applicants must address all three questions. Female applicants should address questions "b" and "c" only.
- 3. The length of the essay will be no less than 300 words, and no more than 500 words.
- 4. The essay must be type-written, double-spaced, and submitted on $8 \frac{1}{2} \times 11$ inch white paper.
- 5. The essay will be accompanied by a cover sheet containing the following: student's name, home address, age, grade, and school presently attending.
- 6. A check in the scholarship amount will be made payable to the student <u>and</u> the college the student plans to attend.
- 7. A statement will be required from the school and a counselor verifying that the student has made the necessary plans to attend college.
- 8. The essay and cover letter must be post marked to this office no later than the date printed on the application and sent to the following address:
