- 4. Please include on the index card your full name (enunciation), congregation, category, and a complete detailed description of attire/outfit to be modeled. (See example below)
- 5. Participants are requested to bring a description of attire with them to Monday night's assembly to be turned in to coordinator.
- 6. Participants are required to come to practice.
