## Joseph Ingram Memorial Scholarship

### Purpose of Scholarship

The scholarship serves as a memorial to Joseph Ingram and his dedicated service to the Southeastern Youth for Christ Conference. Its purpose is to recognize students who have demonstrated a devotion to the cause of Christ, have been active in programs at their local congregation, and have demonstrated leadership potential in the interactions with other youth in the congregation and community.

Applicants must also have demonstrated a desire to further their education.

#### Award

One (1) \$1,000 Scholarship (as funds are available). Scholarship Funds Guidelines

- Scholarship will be awarded to any high school student who is a member of the churches of Christ in the Southeastern region who meet the scholarship criteria.
- The scholarship award may be used at a college of the student's choice
- The Scholarship shall be granted for a period of one year in the amount of \$1,000, as funds are available. It is a nonrenewable scholarship.
- The applicants will be screened by the SEYFCC Scholarship Committee. The decision of the committee shall be final and binding on the recipient.

#### Applicant Criteria

- 1. Students must be faithful and active in the worship and fellowship activities of their home congregation.
- 2. Student must have maintained at least an academic 2.5 average. A certified copy of the transcript will be needed to verify GPA.
- 3. Student must be enrolling or enrolled as a full-time student in a college or university.
- 4. Two letters of recommendation are required and submitted with the application. One letter must be from the Minister, Elder, or a responsible church leader indicating applicant's participation in congregational youth activities as well as faithfulness to worship services and bible classes.

The second letter must attest to the following: that in the view of the one submitting the letter, the student exhibits leadership skills.

- \*Documentation of community service either with church group, school group, or independently.
- 5. Application must be submitted on or before 11:59 p.m. June 30,2025

- 6. Student must be an attendee as well as participant in the Southeastern Regional Youth for Christ Conference. Having participated in at least one of the following activities: leading in one of devotionals (males only) spelling bee, bible bowl, speech competition, art competition, or fashion show.
- 7. Student must submit an essay of at least 500 words on the topic:

How I Reflect The Values of Christ and the Youth For Christ Conference By My Community Participation. **Be specific.** 

The essays will be judged on the following criteria: correct usage of grammar and punctuation, paragraph formation, continuity, relevancy, and creativity.
